Hello Members,

Rugby Alberta and the Sub Union partners are aware of the statements from the Alberta Government regarding their desire to ease restrictions in the province which could include a "phased" plan to remove the Restriction Exemption Program. In order to provide consistent direction and avoid disruption and confusion during the rugby season, the Rugby Alberta Vaccination Policy will remain in effect at this time regardless of changes to government restrictions. The current Vaccination policy review date is June 1st. At that time Rugby Alberta and its partner sub unions will review changes if any are required to our current policy.

This will give time to allow for the different municipal by-laws, provincial mandates, and health Canada to align on a clear cohesive strategy. In addition maintaining the policy helps to align our representative teams, who travel inter-provincially, to other areas that have vaccination polices.

We appreciate your patience as we navigate an ever-changing landscape affected by the pandemic.
