Subject: Vaccination Policy

Hello Members,

Rugby Alberta and the Sub Union partners have been monitoring the provincial government's three-part plan to phase out public health measures. As of February 9th, Alberta officially entered “Step 1” of a three-phased “Return to Normal” approach. This included the recent removal of the Restrictions Exemption Program. If hospitalization numbers continue to trend down, the government of Alberta is expected to announce further changes effective March 1st. (“Step 2”)

The current Vaccination policy review date will move forward to February 28th. At that time Rugby Alberta and its partner Sub Unions will review its current COVID policy and decide if updates are required. We will also have regular reviews of the COVID policy leading up to and during the season.

We appreciate your patience as we navigate an ever-changing landscape affected by the pandemic.
